Key Responsibilities:

• Monitor rider movements:

- Monitor the movements of the competitors whilst on course.
- Ensure rider and public safety by consistently moving throughout the race track.
- Manage incidents according to set guidelines.
- First aid:

- Assist where practicable, in the protection of spectators and competitors, and utilise known first aid techniques, in consultation with the first aid providers.
- Assist first aid providers in the recovery activities of injured/downed riders and the collection of motorcycles.

• Crowd Control and Safety:

- Assist with managing the flow of participants and spectators to ensure safety and order.
- Ensure the intent of the race track is maintained by re-fixing barriers/bunting.
- Report any safety concerns to the Event Clerk of Course and/or Outrider Coordinator, any action of a spectator that may cause the cessation of the event.

• Track Support:

- Provide support on the track, such as flagging, monitoring, and assisting with recovery.
- Communicate with race control regarding track conditions and incidents.

• Miscellaneous Tasks:

- Perform other duties as assigned by the Outrider Coordinator to support the event's success.
- Flexibility to adapt to different roles as needed throughout the event.
- Willingness to undertake a Victorian Working With Childrens Check for Volunteers

Skills and Qualifications:

- Passion for Motorsports:
